Preferred Brands of paint are Americana & Ceramcoat. Quality tube acrylics are acceptable but may not function the same. These are generic & basic colors you might want to have on hand.

Basic brushes

1 to 2" large flat wash brush

³/₄" chisel edge flat brush (higher quality medium flexible synthetic for floating color bristles are usually golden brown with black tips)

 $\frac{1}{2}$ " #8 = $\frac{1}{4}$ " flat chisel edge brushes (higher quality – will last longer and preform much better.)

#1 round and 10/0 liner.

Optional brushes:

foam or cheaper 3/4 to 1" flat brushes for basecoating

1/2" or 3/8" rake (flat brush with staggered & layered bristles Like a shag hair cut for feathers, fur, hair & grass.) Medium stiff, medium size fan brush. Used for foliage, pine trees, grass etc.

Plastic-bristle stipple brush or older ruined brush for pouncing in several sizes.



Suggested Supplies:

Blue Pallet Keeper with sponge by Mastersons; size 12 x 16"

Or make your own temporary wet pallet with a recycled Styrofoam, thin piece of chamois or foam.

<u>Sharpie Permanent Marking Pen</u> extra fine line

<u>Graphite Paper light & dark</u> - not the waxy or carbon type

<u>Tracing Paper</u> or office transparencies <u>Small Sea Sponge</u>

<u>Double ended Stylus</u> – or ball point pen <u>Kneaded Eraser</u>

<u>Blue Painters Tape 3/4"</u> wide (safe Release)

Brush cleaner or "Simple Green House & Siding Pressure washer Cleaner (removes paint fast & doesn't damage the brushes like alcohol does. Available at paint stores) Small reusable <u>fine sanding disc</u> or pieces of typical grocery brown paper bag.

Bar Ivory Soap in a box or baggie

Pencil, ink pen, white charcoal pencil

4" Roller handle & roller cover

Surfaces: watercolor paper, tempered hardboard, canvas, wood & fabric

<u>Graph Ruler</u> A See-thru ruler with grid lines going both ways is best and is necessary for projects with straight lines.

<u>Safety compass</u> <u>toothbrush</u>

Quality Paper towels like bounty or viva

2 shallow <u>water containers</u> – cut off water bottles Brush holder; container with rolled cardboard works 1 qt. white quality latex interior water base paint or white gesso as primer coats (Paint is the preferred)

OTHER SUPPLIES: (OPTIONAL)

Polyurethane Water base Varnish (non-yellowing-only for surfaces to be used heavily to keep the painting clean and prevent scratching.

All Purpose Sealer is needed only if painting on porous woods & papers. Tanning Blocking Sealer for extra tight seal on Knots &d sap is highly recommended.

Folder or 3-Ring Binder for all your class resources, ideas, patterns, & instructions etc.

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
